Recognition is sent once the donation and application are received and processed by LCIF. Please take time to type or print clearly and review the application carefully to ensure accuracy. Incomplete forms may delay processing. When planning a presentation, please allow several weeks for processing.

SECTION 1: DONOR INFORMATION

Donors can be individuals, clubs, districts, multiple districts or other organizations. A receipt or acknowledgement of donation will be sent to whoever is making the donation. If this donation includes contributions from multiple individuals or clubs, please attach a detailed listing of donors and the amount contributed by each donor. Charitable donations are tax deductible as allowed by law.

SECTION 2: DONATION DETAILS

Donations are payable by check/bank draft/money order, wire transfers or credit card for US\$1,000. Make checks payable to LCIF. **Important: Donation checks sent to LCIF must be in U.S. dollars, drawn upon a U.S. financial institution. Non-U.S./Canadian checks sent to LCIF will be returned to the donor.** When determining the amount of local funds required for exchange to U.S. dollars, please use the association's current monthly exchange rate shown on the club statement. Using an exchange rate other than the official association rate may cause a shortage of funds and delay processing of a recognition. Please fax, mail or e-mail a copy of the receipt or wire transfer form to LCIF so that we can match it with the advice from our bank, ensuring completion of the transaction. Include on the form the recipient's name, district, club and member number as well as the donor's name, district and club number, and the form of recognition requested (i.e., MJF, club plaque, etc.). **PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH.** An installment program is also available. Installments can be made toward a fellowship in increments of US\$100 or greater. Donations toward the US\$1,000 needed for a fellowship must be completed within five years. Donors may also request LCIF to use previously donated funds when a recipient has not been named. SECTION 3: RECIPIENT INFORMATION

Melvin Jones Fellowships are bestowed upon an individual (one single recipient) when a donation is made either by the individual or in honor or in memory of an individual. Melvin Jones Fellowship donations are unrestricted (undesigned). Donations to restricted (designated) funds are not eligible for Melvin Jones Fellowship recognition except under special circumstances as directed by the LCIF Executive Board. In instances where a club, district or multiple district is making a donation and intends to name the recipient at a later date, it is not necessary to submit an application form. For memorial donations, please include the name and address of the individual to whom the recognition is being presented.

SECTION 4: SHIPPING INFORMATION

Please include the name, street address, city, state, zip or postal code, country, telephone number and e-mail address, if available, to whom the materials are being shipping. **We are unable to ship recognitions to a PO Box.** In the event that this section is not completed, or there is difficulty in delivering to the ship to address, recognitions will be redirected to a club president, district governor or council chairperson. Refusals of payment of customs charged when warranted will result in abandonment of the shipment. Recognition will not be reshipped in this case unless LCIF receives written notification that any future customs charges will be paid.

What is a Melvin Jones Fellowship?

The fellowship, which was created in 1973, is named in honor of the founder of Lions Cubs International, Melvin Jones. The fellowship was established as LCIF's highest form of recognition to acknowledge an individual's dedication to humanitarian service.

When an individual, club or district donates US\$1,000 to LCIF for a Melvin Jones Fellowship, an inscribed plaque and lapel pin are presented to the specified individual. The recipient being honored does not have to be a Lions member.



Progressive Melvin Jones Fellowship Program

Many Melvin Jones Fellows further their commitment to humanitarian causes by participating in the Progressive Melvin Jones Fellowship Program. Lions clubs and districts also participate by making donations in the name of an individual who is already a Melvin Jones Fellow. For gifts of US\$1,000-US\$100,000, in addition to the initial US\$1,000 donation, fellows receive a lapel pin adorned with various gemstones according to the level of the Progressive Melvin Jones Fellowship program. For example, a Melvin Jones Fellow who donates an additional US\$1,000 will receive a one diamond yellow gold lapel pin. The levels of the Progressive program advance in US\$1,000 increments.
