## Conditions for participation at the competition

- The instrument chosen for the Lions European Musical Competition 2012 is **CELLO**.
- Each member country of the Europa Forum may nominate one and only one candidate for the competition. The registration forms must be sent to the Chairman of the Lions European Musical Competition Committee **by June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012**.
- Candidates must have been resident in the territory of the nominating member country for **at least five years** prior to January 1, 2012 and must be born **after December 31<sup>th</sup>, 1988**.
- Candidates will receive a diploma confirming their participation. The three winners will receive respectively 3.500 EUR, 2.000 EUR and 1.000 EUR.
- Candidates will be required to perform:
  - The imposed piece;
  - Two pieces of their choice out of the repertoire list.
- The competition will take place on September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2012 in **Brussels-Belgium open to the public**:
  - In the afternoon of September 6<sup>th</sup>, all candidates will be asked to perform the imposed piece;
  - In the morning of September 7<sup>th</sup>, they will be asked to perform the 1<sup>st</sup> piece they selected out of the repertoire list;
  - As a result of these two performances, the Jury will select six candidates;
  - The selected six candidates will perform their 2<sup>nd</sup> piece out of the repertoire list in the afternoon of September 7<sup>th</sup> in a concert open to the public.
  - The Jury will select the winners as a result of the three performances.
- The three winners of the competition will be presented at the Closing Ceremony of the 58<sup>th</sup> Europa Forum on September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2012. They will receive their prizes, the 1<sup>st</sup> winner will be asked to play one of the pieces he/she performed.
- For the “concert on the six best” on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and the Closing Ceremony on September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2012 candidates should be dressed fitting the occasion.

**1. FACILITIES:**

**Rehearsal rooms:**

For the “warming-up” (requirements of candidates) there will be available a rehearsal room on Thursday morning of September 6<sup>th</sup>, as will be the case before every presentation.

**2. “GET - TOGETHER”:**

**“Get-together” of Jury and candidates**

On Friday evening, after the competition, a get-together should be planned for jurors, candidates, their accompanists and – possibly – the members of the committee and other persons involved in the event. This little dinner serves two purposes: it allows the candidates to discuss their performance with the jurors and it provides an excellent “closing” for the competition. This dinner will be outside the official Forum programme and the costs for the jurors, candidates and accompanists will be covered by the host country. Other guests will be required to pay for their participation.

**3. HOTEL FACILITIES:**

**Rooms for the candidates:**

Hotel rooms can be reserved for the candidates, for the musician accompanying them or their partner. Cost of a single room is 95,50 EUR a night (upon availability), cost of a twin room is 107,50 EUR a night, from Wednesday September 5<sup>th</sup> to Sunday September 9<sup>th</sup>.

Hotel costs are paid for by the sponsoring district.

Other costs, like meals, are subject to rules set out by the sponsoring district.

You will receive a confirmation of the amount due.

Payment should be done **before** August 1<sup>st</sup> 2012.
